

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF MAX ENTERPRISES, LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 608, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be Max Enterprises, LLC, ("company").

ARTICLE II - ADDRESS

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the company is 5808 Eaure Oak Drive, Lakeland, Florida 33811.

ARTICLE III -- DURATION

The Company shall commence its existence on the date these Articles of Organization are filed by the Florida Department of State. The Company's existence shall be perpetual, unless the Company is earlier dissolved as provided in these Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE IV - REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The name and street address of the registered agent of the company in the state of Florida is: Shelby, Medina & Stargel, LLP, 902 South Florida Avenue, Suite 101, Lakeland, Florida 33803.

ARTICLE V -- CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

The members of the Company shall contribute to the capital of the Company the cash or property as set forth in the Operating Agreement.

ARTICLE VI -- ADDITIONAL CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Articles of Organization of Max Enterprises, LL.C.

Each member shall make additional capital contributions to the Company only on the unanimous consent of all the members, as provided in the Operating Agreement.

ARTICLE VII -- ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS

Except as set forth in the Operating Agreement, no additional members shall be admitted to the Company except with the unanimous written consent of all the members of the Company and on such terms and conditions as shall be determined by all the members. A member may transfer his or her interest in the Company as set forth in the Operating Agreement of the Company, but the transferee shall have no right to participate in the management of the business and affairs of the Company or become a member unless all the other members of the Company other than the member proposing to dispose of his or her interest approve of the proposed transfer by unanimous written consent.

ARTICLE VIII -- TERMINATION OF EXISTENCE

The Company shall be dissolved on the death, bankruptcy, or dissolution of member or manager, or on the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the Company, unless the business of the Company is continued by the consent of all the remaining members, provided there are at least two remaining members.

ARTICLE IX -- MANAGEMENT

The Company shall be managed by managers in accordance with the Operating Agreement adopted by the members for the management of the business and affairs of the Company. This Operating Agreement may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the Company not inconsistent with law or these Articles of Organization.
