**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF

1. NAME OF LIMITED COMPANY. Pursuant to the requirements of Florida Statute 608.406 and 608.407(1)(a) the name of this limited liability company is AMERICAN KNIGHT INSPECTIONS, LLC.

2. AUTHORITY FOR ORGANIZATION. This organization is created under the authority of Florida Statutes 608.401-608.705, the "Florida Limited Liability Act."

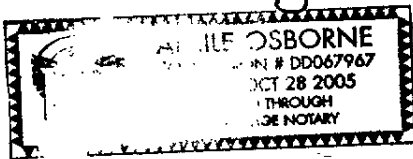


