**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION  
OF  
MOTEL HOLDINGS, LLC**

The undersigned hereby forms a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida.

**ARTICLE I NAME**

The company's name is **Motel Holdings, LLC.**

**ARTICLE II ADDRESS**


