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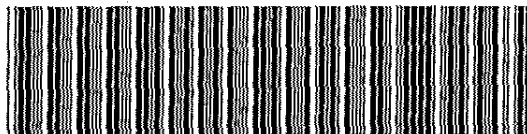

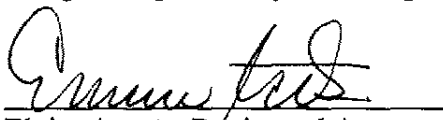

**ARTICLE VII
Nonliability**

(1) All members and managers of the Limited Liability Company, Copperpot Investments, L.L.C., whether founding or subsequently admitted, shall not be liable for any debts, obligations, torts, or liabilities of the Limited Liability Company.

(2) The members and managers of the Limited Liability Company, Copperpot Investments, L.L.C., are not liable, solely by reason of being a member or serving as a manager or managing member, under a judgment, decree, or order of a court, or in any other manner, for a debt, obligation, or liability of the Limited Liability Company.

(3) Any such member, manager, or other person acting under the articles of organization or operating agreement of the Limited Liability Company, Copperpot Investments, L.L.C., is not liable to the limited liability company or to any such other member or manager for the member's, manager's, or other person's good faith reliance on the provisions of the Limited Liability Company's articles of organization or operating agreement.

(4) A manager shall not be personally liable for monetary damages to the Limited Liability Company, Copperpot Investments, L.L.C., its members, or any other person for any statement, vote, decision, or failure to act regarding management or policy decisions by the manager.

ARTICLE VIII

Indemnification of members, managers, officers, employees, and agents

The Limited Liability Company, Copperpot Investments, L.L.C., may, and shall have the power to, but shall not be required to, indemnify and hold harmless any member or manager or other person from and against any and all claims and demands whatsoever.

ARTICLE IX

Miscellaneous

(1) New members can be admitted to the company with full rights of memberships upon the unanimous consent of the existing managing members.

(2) New Members are not managers of the Limited Liability Company, Copperpot Investments, L.L.C., unless so designated and approve by unanimous consent of the existing managing members.

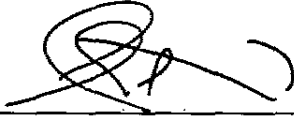

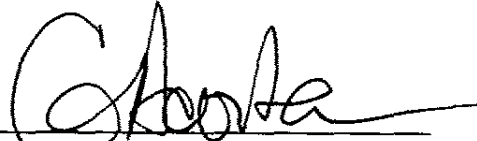
