ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION of CAPALBO PALM BEACH LIQUOR LICENSE, LLC

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We, the undersigned as organizers of a limited liability company, under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act pursuant to Chapter 608, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Organization for such limited liability company:

- 1. <u>Name.</u> The name of the limited liability company is CAPALBO PALM BEACH LIQUOR LICENSE, LLC.
- 2. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of this limited liability company may include the transaction of any and all lawful business for which limited liability companies may be organized in the state of Florida.
- 3. <u>Powers.</u> The limited liability company shall have the same powers as an individual to do all things necessary to carry out its business and affairs, including, without limitation, the power to:
 - (a) Sue and be sued, and defend, in its name.
- (b) Purchase, receive, lease, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, and otherwise deal with real or personal property, or an legal or equitable interest in property, wherever located.
- (c) Sell, convey, mortgage, grant a security interest in, lease, exchange, and otherwise encumber or dispose of all or any part of its property.
- (d) Purchase, receive, subscribe for, or otherwise acquire, own, hold, vote, use, sell, mortgage, lend, grant a security interest in, or otherwise dispose of and deal in and with, shares or other interests in or obligations of any other entity.
- (e) Make contracts or guarantees, or incur liabilities; borrow money; issue its notes, bonds, or other obligations, which may be convertible into or include the option to purchase other securities of the limited liability company; or make contracts of guaranty and suretyship which are necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion, or attainment of the business of a corporation the majority of the outstanding stock of which is owned, directly or indirectly, by the contracting limited liability company; a corporation which owns, directly or indirectly, a majority of the outstanding membership interests of the contracting limited liability company; or a corporation which owns, directly or indirectly, the majority of the outstanding membership interests of the contracting limited liability company,

which contracts of guaranty and suretyship shall be deemed to be necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion, or attainment of the business of the contracting limited liability company; or make other contract of guaranty and suretyship which are necessary or convenient to the conduct, promotion, or attainment of the business of the contracting limited liability company.

- (f) Lend money, invest or reinvest its funds, and receive and hold real or personal property as security for repayment.
- (g) Conduct its business, locate offices, and exercise the powers granted by Chapter 608, Florida Statutes, within or without this state.
- (h) Select managers and appoint officers, directors, employees, and agents of the limited liability company, define their duties, fix their compensation, and lend them money and credit.
- (i) Make donations for the public welfare or for charitable, scientific, or educational purposes.
- (j) Pay pensions and establish pension plans, pension trusts, profit-sharing plans, bonus plans, option plans, and benefit or incentive plans for any or all of its current or former managers, members, officers, agents, and employees.
- (k) Be a promoter, incorporator, shareholder, partner, member, associate, or manager of any corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, or other entity.
- (1) Make payments or donations or do any other act not inconsistent with law that furthers the business of the limited liability corporation.
