ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

(A COMPANY FOR PROFIT)



ARTICLE 1- NAME AND OFFICE

The name of this company shall henceforth be TALLAHASSEE CLINICAL RESEARCH ASSOCIATES, LLC. Its principle office shall be located at 2048 Centre Pointe Lane, in the city of Tallahassee, County of Leon and State of Florida, 32308.

ARTICLE 2- COMPANY PURPOSE

This company is organized and chartered exclusively for clinical research, educational and scientific purposes. Its general purpose is that of fostering a comprehensive approach to community health, and economic and social development. The mission of TALLAHASSEE CLINICAL RESEARCH ASSOCIATES, LLC. is to improve the health status and well being of citizens of Florida and the Southeastern part of the United States of America (USA), with special emphasis on the areas high risk, under-served populations. Its activities will employ a comprehensive approach in recognition of inter-play between socioeconomic factors and health both domestically and internationally with special focus on ethno cultural and genetic contributions to global health and world peace.

As an independent, for-profit company with a flexible administrative framework, the company will be in a unique position to collaborate with Pharmaceutical companies, State and Federal agencies, private and public agencies in the development and the second programs that are responsive to emerging health needs and in the evaluation of these programs that are responsive to emerging health needs to ensure their continued effectiveness. The company will work closely with other health and social service agencies, to cooperatively link public and private organizations, advocacy groups, service providers and community groups, in order to maximize their diverse activities, talents and experiences, to achieve the common goal of improving the health and well being of the citizens of Florida and the South-Eastern part of the United States of America (USA) through Clinical Research, Consumer Education and Applied Evidence-based Science.

To that end, among the activities that the company will be involved, will include but not limited to PRIMARY FOCUS ON CLINICAL RESEARCH; but a secondary emphasis on the following:

- a) Sponsorship of non-profit community and grassroots programs and entities designed to improve the health, social and economic well being of the citizens of Florida and the Southeastern part of the United States of America (USA).
- b) Provision of ongoing health, social and economic services, including health counseling, education, recreation and health services.

- d) Health and social service evaluation and research that supports relevant, costeffective and accountable programs and contributes to the knowledge necessary to effect and sustain successful health and social services policies and programs.
- e) Engagement in other activities and functions as are proper to further the goals and purposes of the company.



ARTICLE III-POWERS

The company is authorized and empowered to do all things necessary to carry on and accomplish the purpose for which it is organized and chartered, including authority and power:

- a) To enter into, make and perform contracts of every kind and description, including, without limitation, contracts for goods and/or services., the review, evaluation, response to and writing of grants, and to other wise acquire, hold, own, mortgage, sell, convey or otherwise dispose of real and personal property for every class and description.
- b) To borrow or raise monies for any of the purposes of the company and from time to time without limit as to amount, to draw, make, accept, endorse, execute and issue promissory notes and other negotiable or non-negotiable instrumental and evidences of indebtedness, and to secure the payment of any thereof and of the interest thereon by mortgage upon the whole or any part of the property of the company whether at the time owned or thereafter acquired, and to sell, pledge or
