ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF HEADLIGHT MOTORZ, LLC ORGANIZED UNDER THE LAWS OF FLORIDA

The undersigned, acting as the organizer of a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act (the "Act"), hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization for HEADLIGHT MOTORZ, LLC (hereinafter called the "Company").

- 1. The name of the Company is HEADLIGHT MOTORZ, LLC.
- 2. - d. To enter into and make all necessary contracts for its business with any person, entity, partnership, association, corporation, domestic or foreign, or of any domestic or foreign state, government, or governmental authority, or of any political or administrative subdivision, or department, and to perform and carry out, assign, cancel, or rescind any of such contracts:
- e. f. To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers set forth in these Articles, either alone or in association with others incidental or pertaining to, or going out of, or connected with its business or powers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.

The several clauses contained in this statement of the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted shall be construed as both purposes and powers of this limited liability company, and statements contained in each clause shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause.
