ARTICLE I NAME AND PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of the limited liability company shall be **GPM, LLC**, (the "Company"), and its principal office shall be located at 3265 16th Avenue Southeast, Naples, Florida, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at any other place or places as the members may designate.
