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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF

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REDDOCH WILLIAMS, M.D., P.L.

I, the undersigned sole member certify that in and for the purpose of becoming a professional limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. I further declare that the following Articles shall serve as the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of the professional limited liability company.

ARTICLE I

NAME AND PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of the limited liability company shall be **REDDOCH WILLIAMS**, M.D., **P.L.**, and its principal office shall be located at 4415 Highway 331 South, Defuniak Springs, FL 32435, and its mailing address shall be 251 Beachview Drive, Fort Walton Beach, FL 32547, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at any other place or places as the members may designate..

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES AND POWERS

- 4. To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers set forth in these Articles, either alone or in association with others incidental or

to, or going out of, or connected with its business or powers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.

The several clauses contained in this statement of the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted shall be construed as both purposes and powers of this limited liability company, and statements contained in each clause shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause. They shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

Nothing contained in these Articles shall be deemed or construed as authorizing or permitting, or purporting to authorize or permit the professional limited liability company to carry on any business, exercise any power, or do any act which a professional limited liability company may not, under Florida laws, lawfully carry on, exercise, or do.

ARTICLE III

EXERCISE OF POWERS
