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ARTICLE OF ORGANIZATION OF MACA, LLC.

The undersigned certify that we have associated ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. We further declare that the following Articles shall serve as the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of the limited company.

ARTICLE

NAME AND PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of this Limited Company shall be: MACA, LLC and its principal office shall be located at 1820 North Corporate Lakes Boulevard, Suite 201, Weston, County of Broward, State of Florida, 33328 but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at any other places of place as the members may designate.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES AND POWERS

In addition to the powers authorized by laws of the State of Florida for limited liability companies, the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted, and which the limited liability company is authorized to transact, shall be as follows:

- To engage in any activity or business authorized under the Florida Statutes.
- 2- In general, to carry on any and all incidental business; to have and exercise all powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida, and to do any and all things set forth in these Articles to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.
- 3- To purchase or otherwise acquire, undertake, carry on, improve, or develop, all or any of the business, good will. Rights, assets, and liabilities

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- of any person, firm, association, or corporation, carrying on any kind of business of a similar nature to that which this limited liability company is authorized to carry on, pursuant to the provisions of these Articles; and to hold, utilize, and in any manner dispose of these rights and property to acquired.
- 4- To enter into and make all necessary contracts for its business with any person, entity, partnership, association, corporation domestic or foreign, or of any domestic or foreign state, government, or governmental authority, or of any political or administrative subdivision, or department, and to perform and carry out, assign, cancel, or rescind any of such contracts.
- 5- To exercise all or any of the limited liability company powers, and to carry out all or any of the purposes, enumerated in these Articles and otherwise granted or parmitted by law, while acting as agent, nominee, or attorney—in-fact for any persons or corporation, and perform any service under contract or otherwise for any corporation, joint stock company association, partnership, firm, syndicate, individual, or other entity, and in its capacity or under this arrangement develop, improve, stabilize, strengthen, or extended the property and commercial interest of the property and aid, assist, or participate an any lawful enterprise in connection with or incidental to the agency, representation, or service, and to render any other service or assistance it may lawfully do under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the information, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit.
- 8- To do everything, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers set forth in these Articles, either alone or in association with others incidental or pertaining to, or going out of, or connected with its business or powers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.

The several clauses contained in this statement of the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted shall be construed as both purposes and powers of this limited liability company, and statements contained in each clause shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause. They shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

Nothing contained in these Articles shall be deemed or construed as authorizing or permitting, or purporting to authorized or permit the limited liability company to carry on any business, exercise any power, or do any act which a limited liability company may not, under Florida laws, lawfully carry on, exercise, or do.

ARTICLE III

EXERCISE OF POWERS

All limited liability company powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of this limited liability company shall be managed under the direction of, the members of this limited liability company. This Article may be amended from time to time in the regulations of the limited liability company by a unanimous vote of the members of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE IV

<u>ARTICLE V</u>

MEMBERSHIP RESTRICTIONS

Members shall have the right to admit new members by unanimous consent. Contributions required of new members shall be determined as of the time of admission to the limited liability company.

A member's interest in the limited liability company may not be sold or otherwise transferred except with unanimous written consent of all members.

On the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, ors dissolution of a member, or the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the limited liability company, the remaining members shall have the right to continue the business on unanimous consent of the remaining members.

<u>ARTICLE VI</u>

CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Capital contribution in the amount of \$ 100 cash shall be pald to the limited liability company by the members in equal shares. Additional contributions will be made as required for investment purposes, as determined by unanimous consent of the members. Members will make contributions in equal shares.

ARTICLE VI

PROFITS AND LOSSES

a- Profit Sharing: The members shall be entitled to the net profits arising from the operation of the limited liability company business that remain after the payment of the expenses of conducting the business of the limited liability company.
