ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION  
OF  
THE MEDICAL PRACTICES OF LENHOLT AND SCHLOSSBERG, P.L.,  
A FLORIDA PROFESSIONAL LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 608, Florida Statutes, hereby makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I -- NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be The Medical Practices of Lenholt and Schlossberg, P.L., a Florida Professional Limited Liability Company (the "Company").

ARTICLE II -- ADDRESS

The mailing and street address of the initial principal office of the Company shall be 2038 Sevilla Way, Naples, Florida 34109.

ARTICLE III -- DURATION

The Company shall commence its existence on the date these Articles of Organization are filed by the Florida Department of State. The Company shall be managed by the members in accordance with the Operating Agreement adopted by the Members for the management of the business and affairs of the Company. The Operating Agreement may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the Company not inconsistent with the law or these Articles of Organization.


