Dear Mr. Blount:

I hereby submit my resignation from my position as Business MGRM and 40% partner of Fabulous Floors, LLC.

I hope you understand that my resignation in no way reflects upon the quality of your flooring work nor your conduct as a professional in the construction industry. Indeed, I feel that your tile and wood laminate work is of the highest quality. I also applied your high standard of ethics and fairness in an industry where greed and corruption are rampant.

Mr. Blount, my resignation is primarily due to our inability to obtain Workers' Compensation Insurance and therefore, the inability of Fabulous Floors, LLC to legally hire any employees. When I agreed to become the Business Manager and 40% partner just over a month ago in the beginning of November, it was with the understanding that Fabulous Floors, LLC was in the process of growing and was going to hire some employees. You would need a Business Manager do the payroll, taxes, insurance, etc. As you know, one of my first tasks as Business Manager was to obtain Workers' Compensation Insurance for Fabulous Floors, LLC - a task which I unfortunately failed to accomplish! All of the insurance companies that I contacted, including the ones listed on the State FWCJUA website as "authorized producers," informed me that they do not provide insurance to companies having fewer than 4 employees. But, as we discussed, it would be illegal for Fabulous Floors, LLC to hire even 1 employee without having Workers' Compensation Insurance! I was told that our only alternative would be to use Employee Leasing/Temporary services which Fabulous Floors cannot presently afford, and in any event, you would not then need me to process the payroll, etc., since this would be handled by the Leasing/Temp agency.

Mr. Blount, the bottom line is that being unable to hire any employees, you cannot generate enough profit to justify having a Business MGRM 40% partner at Fabulous Floors, LLC, nor is it worth my while to provide such services. I have already invested a lot of time and energy, and lost money, in the month and a half that I have been the Business Manager. Unless the State laws and/or insurance protocols were to change, I cannot see this situation improving in the foreseeable future. Therefore, at this time I believe it is in both of our best interests to end the partnership.

Again, I want to emphasize that my resignation has nothing to do with the quality of your work. Also, I agree with your decision to comply with the law and not to hire employees illegally, as has been recommended and practiced by many persons in the industry. Even though your decision will cause financial hardship, I believe you are doing the right thing and you should be commended for your integrity! I also think that with the reputation you are have already gained for the high quality of your work, you will be able to obtain good contracts in the future as an independent contractor. I wish you the best in your future endeavors. May you have a Merry Christmas and Happy New Year.
