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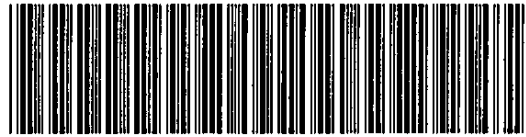

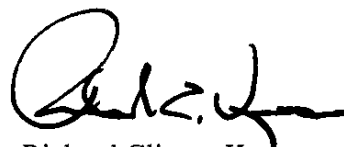

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**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF CONCH SYSTEMS, LLC
A FLORIDA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY**

ARTICLE I – NAME

The name of the limited liability company ("Company") is Conch Systems, LLC, a Florida Limited Liability company, under Chapter 621, F.S.

ARTICLE II – ADDRESS

The mailing and street address of the Company's principal office is 1113 First Street, Neptune Beach, Florida 32266.

ARTICLE III – DURATION

The period of duration for the Company is Thirty (30) years, beginning on the date these Articles of Organization are filed with the Florida Department of State.

ARTICLE IV – REGISTERED AGENT AND OFFICE

(A) The power to adopt, alter, amend, or repeal these Articles, or the Operations or Regulations of the Company, is vested entirely in the Member(s) listed in Article V.

(B) The Members may also adopt, alter, amend or repeal any other provisions not inconsistent with law that such Members desire to specify for the operation or regulation of internal affairs of limited liability companies.

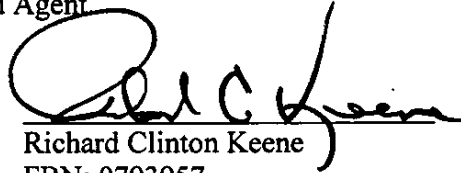
