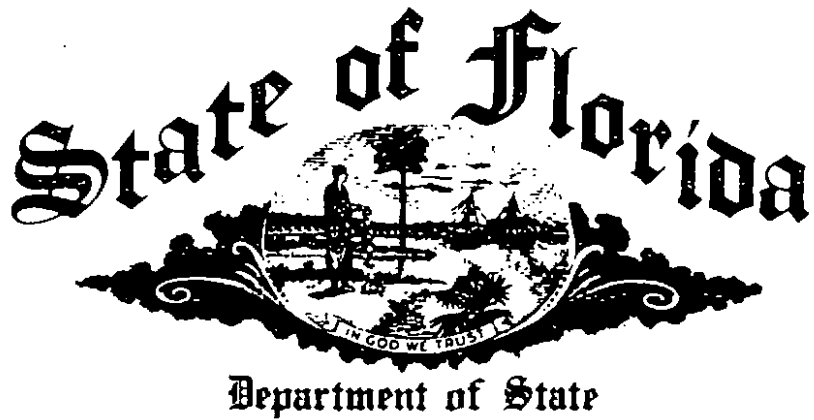

It has been brought to our attention by Dean Mead Services, LLC, the registered agent designated on the 2018 annual report for the two entities named above was done so without their acceptance. Dean Mead Services, LLC resigned as the agent on March 28, 2018. They also provided a copy of a letter sent to Jack L. Moore on the same date of such resignation.
