

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF IMAGE READERS OF AMERICA, L.L.C.

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The undersigned certify that we have associated ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. We further declare that the following Articles shall serve as the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE I

NAME, MAILING ADDRESS AND PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of the limited liability company shall be IMAGE READERS OF AMERICA, L.L.C., and its mailing address and street address of the principal office shall be at located at 6363 S.W. 87th Lane, City of Miami, County of Miami-Dade, State of Florida, 33143, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at any other place or places as the members may designate. The mailing address shall be the same.

ARTICLE II

The address of the initial registered office of the limited liability company is 6363 S.W. 87th Lane, City of Miami, County of Miami-Dade, State of Florida, 33143, and the name of the company's initial registered agent at that address is Antonio Burnett, M.D.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES AND POWERS

In addition to the powers authorized by the laws of the State of Florida for limited liability companies, the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted, and which the limited liability company is authorized to transact, shall be as follows:

- (1) To engage and conduct business for profit in the State of Florida including, but not limited to, rendering general radiology and imaging interpretation.
- (2) In general, to carry on any and all incidental business; to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida, and to do any and all things set forth in these Articles to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.
- (3) To purchase or otherwise acquire, undertake, carry on, mortgage, borrow and lend money, improve, or develop, all or any of the business, good will, rights, assets, and liabilities of any person, firm, association, or corporation carrying on any kind of business of a similar nature

to that which this limited liability company is authorized to carry on, pursuant to the provisions of these Articles; and to hold, utilize, and in any manner dispose of the rights and property so acquired.

- (4) To enter into and make all necessary contracts for its business with any person, entity, partnership, association, corporation, domestic or foreign, or of any domestic or foreign state, government, or governmental authority, or of any political or administrative subdivision, or department, and to perform and carry out, assign, cancel, or rescind any of such contracts.
- (5) To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers set forth in these Articles, either alone or in association with others incidental or pertaining to, or going out of, or connected with its business or powers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.

The several clauses contained in this statement of the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted shall be construed as both purposes and powers of this limited liability company, and statements contained in each clause shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause. They shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

Nothing contained in these Articles shall be deemed or construed as authorizing or permitting, or purporting to authorize or permit the limited liability company to carry on any business, exercise any power, or do any act which a limited liability company may not, under Florida laws, lawfully carry on, exercise, or do.

ARTICLE IV

EXERCISE OF POWERS

All limited liability company powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of the Operating Agreement and the business and affairs of this limited liability company shall be managed under the direction of the members of this limited liability company. This Article may be amended from time to time in the regulations of the limited liability company by a unanimous vote of the members of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE V

MANAGEMENT

The limited liability company shall be managed by the Managers. The LLC is a Manager-Managed Company. The name and address of the initial Managing Directors are Antonio Burnett, M.D., P.A., 6363 S.W. 87th Lane, Miami, Florida 33143, Siddharth Pandya, P.A., 400 N.W. 107th Avenue, Plantation, FL 33324 and M. Arulpitchai Narayanan, M.D., 27 Gangai Street, Kalakshetra Colony, Chennai, India, who shall serve until a successor manager is elected.

ARTICLE VI

ADMISSION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBERS

Members shall have the right to admit new members by unanimous written consent. Contributions required of new members shall be determined as of the time of admission to the limited liability company.

A member's interest in the limited liability company may not be sold or otherwise transferred except with the unanimous written consent of Antonio Burnett, M.D., P.A., Siddharth Pandya, P.A. and M. Arulpitchai Narayanan, M.D.

ARTICLE VII

CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Capital contributions in the amount of \$6,000.00 cash shall be paid to the limited liability company by the three (3) members in equal \$2,000.00 shares. Additional contributions will be made as required for investment purposes, as determined by unanimous consent of the members. Members will make contributions in equal shares.

ARTICLE VIII

PROFITS AND LOSSES

- (a) *Profit Sharing*. The members shall be entitled to the net profits arising from the operation of the limited liability company business that remain after the payment of the expenses of conducting the business of the limited liability company. Each member shall be entitled to an equal distributive share of the profits. The distributive share of the profits shall be determined and paid to the members on or before the March 15th following the end of each calendar year, or such earlier date as determined by the Managers.
- (b) Losses. All losses that occur in the operation of the limited liability company business shall be paid out of the capital of the limited liability company and the profits of the business.

ARTICLE IX

MEMBERS' RIGHTS TO CONTINUE BUSINESS

On the occurrence of any event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the limited liability company, the remaining members shall have the right to admit additional members and to continue the business on unanimous consent of the remaining members.

ARTICLE X

DURATION

This limited liability company shall exist until dissolved in a manner provided by law.

To avoid dissolution under this section, the limited liability company must have at least two (2) remaining members. If a disassociation leaves the limited liability company with only one (1) remaining member, that member may admit an additional member in order to continue the limited liability company within a reasonable time as proscribed by the laws of the state of Florida.

ARTICLE XI

RELATIONSHIP OF ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION TO OPERATING AGREEMENT

If a provision of these Articles of Organization differs from a provision of the limited liability company's Operating Agreement then, to the extent allowed by law, the Operating Agreement will govern.

ARTICLE XII

INSURANCE

The limited liability company may purchase and maintain insurance on behalf of a member in that member's official capacity and any liability asserted against and incurred by the member in or arising from that capacity, whether or not the limited liability company would have been required to indemnify the member against the liability.

ARTICLE XIII

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The name of the limited liability company is IMAGE READERS OF AMERICA, L.L.C.

The address of the initial registered office of the limited liability company is 6363 S.W. 87th Lane, City of Miami, County of Miami-Dade, State of Florida, 33143, and the name of the company's initial registered agent at that address is Antonio Burnett, M.D.

The undersigned, being an original member of the limited liability company, certifies that this instrument constitutes the proposed Articles of Organization of IMAGE READERS OF AMERICA, L.L.C.
