ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

SALON OLLUS & SPA, LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Florida Statutes Chapter 608, hereby makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE 1 - NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be **SALON OLLUS** & **SPA**, **LLC**.

ARTICLE 2 - ADDRESS

The principal place of business of the Company is Florida shall be:

ARTICLE 3 - EFFECTIVE DATE

The limited liability company's existence will begin effective April 1, 2007.

ARTICLE 4 -DURATION

ARTICLE 8 - ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBER DE REPORT AND STATE OF STATE O

Member(s) of the limited liability company have the right to admit new members. Additional members may be admitted only on the unanimous written consent of the existing member(s), and the existing member(s) shall determine the amount and nature of contributions by new members at the time new members are admitted.

ARTICLE 9 - TRANSFERABILITY OF MEMBERSHIP INTERESTS

No member shall have the right to assign their membership interests in the Company without the written agreement of all of the membership interests. If the assignment is not approved by all of the membership interests, the assignee shall merely be entitled to receive the share of profits and other distributions and the allocation of income, gain, loss deduction, credit or similar item to which the assignor was entitled, to the extent assigned.

ARTICLE 10 - TERMINATION OF EXISTENCE

The Company shall be dissolved upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member or the occurrence of any other event which terminates rule continued membership of a member in the Company, unless the business of the Company is continued by the consent of the remaining members, provided there are at least one remaining member.

ARTICLE 11 - INDEMNIFICATION AND INSURANCE

The Company shall indemnify members of the Company who was wholly successful, on the merits or otherwise, in the defense of any proceeding to which the managers and/or members was a party because the managers and/or members is or was a manager and/or member of the Company against reasonable attorney fees and expenses incurred by the managers and/or members in connection with the proceeding.

The Company may indemnify an individual made a party to a proceeding because the individual is or was a member, manager, employee or agent of the Company against liability if authorized in the specific case after determination, in the manner required by the member(s), that indemnification of the member, manager, employee or agent, as the case may be, is permissible in the circumstances because the member, manager, employee or agent has met the standard of conduct set forth by the member(s).

All references in these Articles of Organization are deemed to include any amendment or successor thereto.

Nothing contained in these Articles of Organization shall limit or preclude the exercise of any right relating to indemnification or advance of attorney fees and expenses to any person who is or was a member, manager, employee or agent of the Company or the ability of the Company otherwise to indemnify or advance expenses to any such person by contract or nearly other manner. If any word, clause or sentence of the foregoing provisions regarding indemnification or advancement of the attorney fees or expenses shall be held invalid as contrary to law or public policy, it shall be severable and the provisions remaining shall not be otherwise affected. All references in these Articles of Organization to "member", "manager", "employee" and magent" shall include the heirs, estates, executors, administrators and personal representatives of such persons
