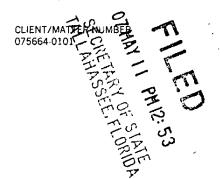

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

A Florida Limited Liability Company

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 608, Florida Statutes, and for the purpose of forming an alliance to pool and spread liabilities of its members relative to property exposure in accordance with Section 395.106, Florida Statutes, hereby makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I **NAME**

The name of the Limited Liability Company is as follows:

ARTICLE IV MANAGEMENT

The Company shall be managed by the Company's Board of Managers in accordance with the Company's Operating Agreement adopted by the members for the management of the business and affairs of the Company. The Operating Agreement may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the Company not inconsistent with law or these Articles of Organization. The name and address of the initial Managers of the Company are:

ARTICLE V DURATION

The Company shall commence its existence on May 11, 2007. The Company's existence shall be perpetual, unless otherwise dissolved as provided in these Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE VI ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS AND TRANSFERABILITY OF INTERESTS

Membership in the Company shall be limited to (i) special districts created pursuant to a special act of the Florida Legislature and having the authority to own or operate one or more hospitals licensed in Florida, and (ii) hospitals licensed in Florida that are owned, operated, or funded by a county or municipality. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no entity may be a member of the Company unless such entity is an Eligible Entity. For this purpose, "Eligible Entity" means (a) the State of Florida, (b) a political subdivision (within the meaning of section 103(c)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code")) of the State of Florida, or (c) a Florida nonprofit corporation that is exempt from federal income tax under section 115(1) of the Code. The Board of Managers of the Company shall require any entity seeking to become a member of the Company to submit a request for membership to the Board of Managers of the Company, which may then offer membership to such entity in accordance with the Company's Operating Agreement.

No member shall be entitled to sell, transfer, assign, pledge, encumber or make any other disposition of its rights or interests as a member; provided, however, that in the event a member is merged or consolidated into another Eligible Entity, or substantially all of the assets of a member are sold to another Eligible Entity, or a portion of the member's operations that are insured or reinsured by the Company is sold or transferred by the member to another Eligible Entity, the member may transfer its membership to the transferee Eligible Entity in accordance with the procedure specified in the Company's Operating Agreement.

ARTICLE VII -- TERMINATION OF EXISTENCE

The Company may be dissolved by its Members in accordance with the procedure specified in the Operating Agreement. Upon dissolution of the Company, none of the assets of the Company remaining after the payment of liabilities may be distributed to any person or entity other than an Eligible Entity.

In accordance with section 608.408(3), Florida Statutes, the execution of this document constitutes an affirmation under the penalties of perjury that the facts stated herein are true.
