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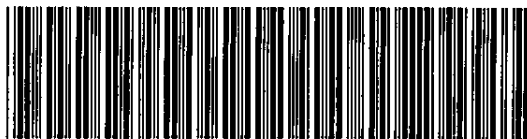

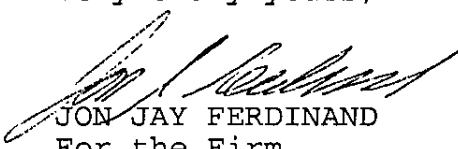

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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

LYCHEE JUNGLE, LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a Limited Liability Company under the Florida Limited Liability Act, F.S. Chapter 608, hereby makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I
NAME

The name of this limited liability company is **LYCHEE JUNGLE, LLC** (hereinafter "the Company").

ARTICLE II
MAILING AND STREET ADDRESS

The mailing and street address of the principal office of the Company is **2557 "D" Road, Loxahatchee, FL 33470.**

ARTICLE III
PURPOSE AND POWERS

The general purpose for which the Company is organized is to own and hold real property, and to conduct other activities incident to same. The Company shall also be authorized to transact any lawful business for which a Limited Liability Company may be organized under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, as amended from time to time. The Company shall have all the powers granted to a Limited Liability Company under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV
DURATION

The Company shall commence its existence upon the filing of these Articles of Organization, and its existence shall be perpetual unless the Company is dissolved in accordance with the Operating Agreement adopted from time to time by the members for the management of the business and affairs of the Company or as otherwise provided under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act. Such Operating Agreement may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the Company not inconsistent with these Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE V
REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The name and street address of the registered agent of the Company in the State of Florida is **Ferdinand & Sullivan, P.A., whose address is 100 W. Cypress Creek Road, Suite 910, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33309.**

ARTICLE VI
MANAGEMENT

The Company is to be managed by one or more Managers. The person who will serve as the Manager until the first annual meeting of members or until his or her successor is elected and qualified is:

ARTICLE VII
MEMBERS CANNOT BIND THE COMPANY

This Company is managed exclusively by one or more Managers, and therefore is a manager-managed company and members have no authority to bind it.

ARTICLE VIII
ADMISSION OF ADDITIONAL MEMBERS

Members of the Company have the right to admit new members only upon the written consent of all existing members, and the existing members shall determine the amount and nature of contributions by new members at the time new members are admitted. An assignee of a member's interest in the Company may become a member only if all existing members consent in writing.

ARTICLE IX
INVOLUNTARY ASSIGNMENT OF MEMBER INTEREST

In the event that a Member's interest in the Company is taken involuntarily, by levy, foreclosure, charging order, execution, or other similar proceeding, the Company shall not dissolve. The assignee of the Member's interest shall be entitled to no more than to receive the profits and losses attributable to said interest and shall not be entitled to participate in any respect in the management or administration of the Company's business or affairs.

ARTICLE X
LIMITATION ON MEMBER WITHDRAWAL

No Member of the Company has the right to withdraw or reduce her or his capital contribution to the Company except upon the written consent of all existing members.
