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ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO  
ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF  
TREETOP SOFTWARE COMPANY, LLC

Pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 608.411, the Articles of Organization of TREETOP SOFTWARE COMPANY, LLC, are hereby amended as follows:

1. The name of the limited liability company is TREETOP SOFTWARE COMPANY, LLC (the "Company").
2. The Articles of Organization of the Company were filed with the office of the Florida Department of State on July 17, 2007, and the document number is L07000073804.
3. The Articles of Organization of the Company are hereby amended to include an additional Article, which shall read as follows:

"ARTICLE 6 – Manager Considerations

In discharging his or her duties, and in determining what is in the best interests of the Company and its members, a manager shall not be required to regard any interest, or the interests of any particular group affected by such action, as a dominant or controlling interest or factor.

He or she shall give due consideration to the following factors, including, but not limited to, the long-term prospects and interests of the Company and its members, and the social, economic, legal, or other effects of any action on the current and retired employees, the suppliers and customers of the Company or its subsidiaries, and the communities and society in which the Company or its subsidiaries operate, (collectively, with the members, the "Stakeholders"), together with the short-term, as well as long-term, interests of its members and the effect of the Company's operations (and its subsidiaries' operations) on the environment and the economy of the state, the region and the nation.

Nothing in this Article, express or implied, is intended to create or shall create or grant any right in or for any person or any cause of action by or for any person.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, any manager is entitled to rely upon the definition of "best interests" as set forth above in enforcing his or her rights hereunder and under state law, and such reliance shall not, absent another breach, be construed as a breach of a manager's fiduciary duty of care, even

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in the context of a change in control where, as a result of weighing other Stakeholders' interests, a manager determines to accept an offer, between two competing offers, with a lower price per unit."
