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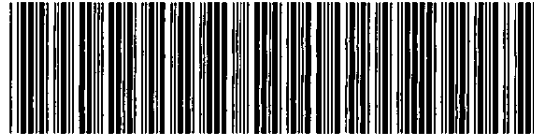

**ARTICLE I: ORGANIZATION NAME**

The name of the limited liability company is Warlocks International, LLC.

**ARTICLE II: ORGANIZATION ADDRESS**

**ARTICLE III: RESIDENT AGENT, REGISTERED OFFICE, AND SIGNATURE**

**ARTICLE IV: NAME AND ADDRESS OF MANAGING MEMBER**

The name and street address of the managing member is John E. Boudreau, 1109 Dixon Blvd., Cocoa, FL 32922.

## **ARTICLE V: PURPOSE**

The limited liability company is organized exclusively for the pleasure, recreation, and other similar nonprofitable purposes of its members and substantially all of its activities must be for these purposes. The Organization is instrumental in promoting personal contact, commingling and face-to face fellowships for its members that share a common interest, riding and ownership of motorcycles.

The Organization will not discriminate against any person based on race, color or religion.

Membership is limited. Candidates must display skills and attitudes consistent with the Organization's values prior to becoming a member and the candidate must be approved by a vote of the members.

In general, the Organization is supported solely by membership fees, dues and assessments. In no cases will unrelated income exceed 35% of gross receipts and no more than 15% of gross receipts will be derived from the general public stemming from the use of the Organization's facilities or services

No part of the earnings of the limited liability company shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members or other private persons, except that the Organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation of services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these articles of organization.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted for an (a) organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code. or by a non-profit organization organized under the laws of the State of Florida.

Upon the dissolution of the Organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(7) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively of such purposes.

## ARTICLE VI: AMENDMENTS

This Organization reserves the right to amend or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Organization, or any amendment hereto.
