



## ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF

### WENTWORTH MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATES, LLC

THESE ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Florida Statutes Chapter 608, are made and executed as of the \_\_\_\_\_ day of May, 2008, by the undersigned person.

- 1. Name. The name of the limited liability company is Wentworth Management Associates, LLC (herein sometimes referred to as the "Company"). These Articles of Organization shall be effective immediately upon approval of the Secretary of the State of Florida.
