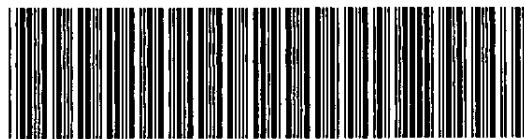

ARTICLE VI. ASSETS


All property and assets have been distributed to the member in accordance with his respective rights and interests.
