Articles of Organization

ARTICLE III......PURPOSES

The company shall have the power to engage in any lawful activity for which limited liability companies may be formed under the Limited Liability Company Law of Florida.

ARTICLE IV......DURATION

ARTICLE VI.

MANAGEMENT

All actions requiring the vote of the members shall be as may be specified in the operating agreement, or if it is not specified, then by a majority vote.

ARTICLE VII.

AUTHORITY TO BIND COMPANY

If the operating agreement of the members authorize a manager or managers, then a manager or managers (or a majority, if more than two) are authorized to negotiate and executes contracts and other transactions in the company's name and behalf for which the company, but none of its individual members, shall be liable. However, no immovable property belonging to the company may be sold, exchanged, leased, mortgaged, or otherwise alienated or encumbered

without the express authorization or joinder by a majority of the members, or as set forth in a power of attorney. Third parties may rely upon a certificate of the company, signed by an authorized manager, or one or more members, that names the persons or managers who have authority to act on behalf of the company, to establish the membership of any member, and to establish the authenticity of any records of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE VIII......AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

Whenever amendments to these articles or certificates of correction are required by law, or by actions of a majority of the members, the amendments or certificates shall be executed by one or more members designated by majority votes of the members, and such amended articles and/or certificates of correction shall be filed and recorded in accordance with law.

ARTICLE IX.....OPERATING AGREEMENT

The members, by a majority of members or the member interest voting, may enter into an operating agreement to prescribe and govern all matters which may lawfully be subjects of such agreements, including any matters not covered by these articles. To the extent that any provisions of such agreement are inconsistent with these articles, the agreement shall govern as among the members, signatories thereto, but any third parties may rely on the provisions of these articles, alone, unless and until the operating agreement is recorded in the public records of the company's parish of domicile.
