Description of Dissolution Circumstances

New Horizons Senior Solutions and Transport LLC

Circumstances:

The recent national and Florida based economic recession affected both the business owner, David P. Caufield and his wife, Andrea D. Caufield. While the prospects for further growth of the geriatric care management and transport business remained promising in Sarasota, the business income was insufficient to provide for the family unit. Andrea D. Caufield, a registered Dental Hygienist suffered a job loss when her employer's dental practice failed. Local community colleges in the area have produced an oversupply of dental hygienists resulting in very limited job replacement opportunities. The business owner at this same time was presented with a significant cash offer from a foreign buyer for the family home-also the initial primary business location at 2229 Cork Oak St W, Sarasota, FL 34232. This offered a chance to clear the mortgage and debt and make a fresh start. The home was sold and the business owner elected to relocate to Tallahassee Florida in hopes that his wife would find better employment prospects in Tallahassee and there would be sufficient numbers of retired seniors in need of medical advocacy and care management to allow the business to grow again in the new location.

Outcome:

The business owner's wife found employment that quickly grew into full time work in her field shortly after arriving in Tallahassee in March 2011. The business owner balanced employment search and business marketing and had some success in both areas. Ultimately the business marketing efforts in Tallahassee resulted in an initial offer of near full time work at Ability 1st, a non-profit organization advocating for persons with disabilities in Tallahassee. Employment started there on September 6, 2011. In December 2012, management staff being satisfied with the business owner's performance offered him full time work. From September 6, 2011 until December 2012 it was still possible to service a client of New Horizons Senior Solutions on Fridays outside of employment obligations with Ability 1st. Once Ability 1st employment moved to full time work schedule with periodic weekend obligations it was not possible to keep the business going.

Conclusion:

Currently the steady employment and benefits offered to the business owner meet financial needs in the currently persistent recession. With a smaller senior retirement population who has private funding sufficient to utilize the services of geriatric care management in Tallahassee, I the business owner of New Horizons Senior Solutions and Transport LLC elect to request the dissolution of this business at this time unless conditions change significantly in the next year. I understand that I have the option to start the business back up with the same name for a period of 1 year and that if I fail to do so within that time period, my only recourse would be to start a new business under a different name.
