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

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

of

INDRAN, L.L.C.,

A Florida Limited Liability Company.

The undersigned certifies that he has executed the foregoing Articles of Organization for the purpose of becoming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida and providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. I further declare that the following Articles shall serve as the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE I

NAME AND PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of the limited liability company shall be **INDRAN**, **L.L.C.**, and its principal office shall be located at 4771 Bayou Blvd., Pensacola, FL 32503, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at any other place or places as the members may designate. The mailing address of the company shall be 4771 Bayou Blvd., Pensacola, FL 32503.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES AND POWERS

In addition to the powers authorized by the laws of the State of Florida for limited liability companies, the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted and which the limited liability company is authorized to transact shall be as follows:

- To engage in investing and managing assets and properties for the company' from time to time.
- 2. To engage in any activity or business authorized under the Florida Statutes.
- 3. In general, to carry on any and all incidental business, to have and exercise above powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida, and to do any and all things set forth in these Articles to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.

- 4. To purchase or otherwise acquire, undertake, carry on, improve, or develop, all or any of the business, good will, rights, assets, and liabilities of any person, firm, association, or corporation carrying on any kind of business of a similar nature to that which this limited liability company is authorized to carry on, pursuant to the provisions of these Articles; and to hold, utilize, and in any manner dispose of the rights and property so acquired.
- 5. To enter into and make all necessary contracts for its business with any person, entity, partnership, association, corporation, domestic or foreign, or of any domestic or foreign state, government, or governmental authority, or of any political or administrative subdivision, or department, and to perform and carry out, assign, cancel, or rescind any of such contracts.
- 6. To exercise all or any of the limited liability company powers, and to carry out all or any of the purposes, enumerated in these Articles and otherwise granted or permitted by law, while acting as agent, nominee, or attorney-in-fact for any persons or corporations, and perform any service under contract or otherwise for any corporation, joint stock company, association, partnership, firm, syndicate, individual, or other entity, and in this capacity or under this arrangement develop, improve, stabilize, strengthen, or extend the property and commercial interest of the property and to aid, assist, or participate in any lawful enterprise in connection with or incidental to the agency, representation, or service, and to render any other service or assistance it ma lawfully do under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit.
- 7. To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers set forth in these Articles, either alone or in association with others incidental or pertaining to, or going out of, or connected with its business or powers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.

The several clauses contained in this statement of the general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted shall be construed as both purposes and powers of this limited liability company, and statements contained in each clause shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause. They shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers.

Nothing contained in these Articles shall be deemed or construed as authorizing or permitting, or purporting to authorize or permit the limited liability company to carry on any business, exercise any power, or do any act which a limited liability company may not, under Florida laws, lawfully carry on, exercise, or do.

ARTICLE III

EXERCISE OF POWERS

All limited liability company powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of this limited liability company shall be managed under the direction of, the members of this limited liability company. This Article may be amended from time to time in the regulations of the limited liability company by a unanimous vote of the members of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE IV

MANAGEMENT

Management of this limited liability company is reserved to its managing member, whose name and address is as follows: Dale L. Carlton, Trustee, Carlton Irrevocable Trust, dated 2/25, 4253 Royal Ridge Drive, Dallas, TX 75299.

ARTICLE V

MEMBERSHIP RESTRICTIONS

Members shall have the right to admit new members by unanimous consent. Principles required of new members shall be determined as of the time of admission to the limited liability company.

A member's interest in the limited liability company may not be sold or otherwise transferred except with unanimous written consent of all members.

On the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member, or the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the limited liability company, the remaining members shall have the right to continue the business on unanimous consent of the remaining members.

ARTICLE VI

CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Capital contributions in an amount to be determined by the initial member herein shall be paid in cash, property, and/or in kind. Additional contributions will be made as required for investment purposes as determined by unanimous consent of the members.

ARTICLE VII

COMMENCEMENT AND DURATION

This limited liability company shall commence on the date duly chartered by the State herein and shall exist until dissolved in a manner provided by law or as provided in the regulations adopted by the members.

ARTICLE VIII

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The address of the initial registered office of the limited liability company is 4771 Bayou Boulevard, Pensacola, FL 32503, and the name of the company's initial registered agent at that address is Arnold F. Carlton.

The undersigned, being the original member of the limited liability company, certify that this instrument constitutes the proposed Articles of Organization of Indran, LLC.


