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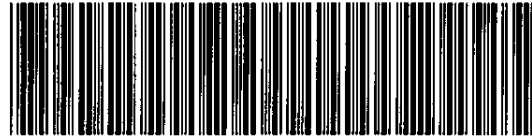



The undersigned subscribers, PHYLLIS LARKIN and MICHAEL LARKIN, natural persons competent to contract, herewith file these Articles of Organization pursuant to Section 608.407 Florida Statutes for such organization.

ARTICLE ONE. Name.

The name of the organization is CHUTES 'N LADDERS, LLC. The business address of the organization is 13425 Muriel Avenue, Port Charlotte, Florida 33981, the mailing address is 3528 Como Street, Port Charlotte, Florida 33948, and such other and further addresses as shall be adopted by the manager from time to time.

ARTICLE TWO. Nature of Business.

The general business to be transacted by this organization is as follows:

1. Any business, as defined in Section 608.402 Florida Statutes.
2. To establish, purchase, lease as lessee, or otherwise acquire, to own, operate, and maintain, and to sell, mortgage, deed in trust, lease as lessor, and otherwise dispose of retail stores or departments therein; to buy, sell, trade, manufacture, deal in, and deal with goods, wares, and merchandise of every kind and nature, and to carry on such business as wholesaler, retailer, importer, and exporter; to acquire all such merchandise, supplies, materials, and other articles that shall be necessary or incidental to such business; and to have any and all powers above set forth as fully as a natural person, whether as principal, agent, trustee, or otherwise.

To purchase, to receive by way of gift, subscribe for, invest in and in all other ways, acquire, import, lease, possess, maintain, handle on consignment, own, hold for investment or otherwise, enjoy, exercise, operate, manage, conduct, perform, make, borrow, guarantee, contract in respect of, trade and deal in, sell, exchange, let, lend, export, mortgage, pledge, deed in trust, hypothecate, encumber, transfer, assign and in all ways dispose of, design, develop, invent, improve, equip, repair, alter, fabricate, assemble, build, construct, operate, manufacture, plant, cultivate, produce, market, and in all ways deal in and with property of every kind and character, real, personal or mixed, tangible or intangible, wherever situated and however held, including, but not limited to, money, credit, choses in action, securities, stocks, bonds, warrants, script, certificates, debentures, mortgages, notes, commercial paper and other obligations and evidences of interest in or indebtedness of any person, firm or corporation, foreign or domestic, or of any government or subdivision or agency thereof, documents of title, and accompanying rights, and every other kind and character of personal property, real property, and the products and avails thereof, and every character of interest therein and appurtenance thereto.
4. To have and to exercise all the powers now or hereafter conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon limited liability companies organized pursuant to the laws under which this organization is organized and any and all acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto.
