Recently, I began to renew my LLC online. The online site (sunbiz.org) had stated that it would be \$521.24 to reinstate. After starting a "reinsatement" process, a lady in the Department of State (DOS) in Tallahassee informed me that I actually needed to "re-register" and pay a \$160.00 fee. I told her that I had already begun the "reinstatement" process. When I went back to the website to re-register, I went through all the proper forms and paid the fee for re-registering.

I then received an e-mail from Joey Bryan in the DOS stating that because I had filled out the reinstatement forms, my re-registration was invalid. When I called and spoke to Joey Bryan, he told me that I needed to fax a letter stating that "I have no intention of reinstating, therefore, releasing the name for use to another entity" (see attached e-mail).
