

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

NISSI MANAGEMENT SERVICES LLC

The undersigned, for the purposes of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Florida Statutes Chapter 608, hereby makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization.

- 1. Name. The name of the limited liability company shall be NISSI MANAGEMENT SERVICES Limited Liability Company (hereinafter referred to as the "Company").
- 2. Address. The Principal place of business of the Company in Florida shall be 2500 Quantum Lakes Drive, Suite 203, Boynton Beach, Florida 33426 and the mailing address shall be P.O. Box 541082, Greenacres, Florida 33454.
- 3. **Effective Date**: These Articles of Organization shall be effective January 1, 2011 upon approval of the Secretary of State, State of Florida.
- 4. **Duration:** The Company's existence shall terminate no later than 99 years from its date of commencement, unless the Company is earlier dissolved as provided in these Articles of Organization or the provisions of the Company's Operating Agreement.
- 5. **Purpose and Powers**. The character and purposes of the Company and its business are (1) real estate acquisitions; (2) corporate housing; (3) to engage in any lawful act or activity for which companies may be organized under the laws of the State of Florida; (4) to do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in association with others, and incidental or pertaining to, or growing out of, or connected with, its business or powers, provided the same is consistent with the laws of the State of Florida.

- 6. **Registered Office and Agent**. 12. Indemnification. All references in these Articles of Organization are deemed to include any amendment or successor thereto. Nothing contained in these Articles of Organization shall limit or preclude the exercise of any right relating to the indemnification or advance of attorney fees and expenses to any person who is or was a manager, officer, employee or agent of the Company or the ability of the Company otherwise to indemnify or advance expenses to any such person by contract or in any other manner. If any word, clause or sentence of the foregoing provisions regarding indemnification or advancement of the attorney fees or expenses shall be held invalid as contrary to law or public policy, it shall be severable and the provisions remaining shall not be otherwise affected. All references in these Articles of Organization to "manager", "officer", "employee" and "agent" shall include heirs, estates, executors, administrators and personal representatives of such persons.
