ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

FLORIDA ALL-STAR PANTHERS, LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Florida Statutes Chapter 608, hereb makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE 1 - NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be FLORIDA ALL-STAPANTHERS, LLC ("Company").

ARTICLE 2 - ADDRESS

The principal place of business of the Company in Florida shall be 1965 Southwest 134th Avenue, Miami, Florida 33177 and the mailing address shall be th same.

ARTICLE 3 - EFFECTIVE DATE

These Articles of Organization shall be effective immediately upon approval c the Secretary of State, State of Florida.

ARTICLE 4 - DURATION

Subject to the provisions of Article 8, the Company's existence shall terminat no later than 99 years from its date of commencement, unless the Company is earlied dissolved as provided in these Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE 5 - PURPOSES AND POWERS

The general purpose for which the Company is organized is to engage in th business of cheerleading and dance training and to transact any lawful business for which a limited liability company may be organized under the laws of the State of Florida. The Company shall have all the powers granted to a limited liability compan under the laws of the State of Florida.



ARTICLE 6 - REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

ARTICLE 7 - ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS

No additional member(s) shall be admitted to the Company except with th unanimous written consent of all the member(s) of the Company and upon such term and conditions as shall be determined by all the member(s). A member may transfe his or her interest in the Company as set forth in the regulations of the Company, but the transferee shall have no right to participate in the management of the business an affairs of the Company or become a member unless all the other member(s) of the Company other than the member proposing to dispose of his or her interest approved the proposed transfer by unanimous written consent.

ARTICLE 8 - TERMINATION OF EXISTENCE

The Company shall be dissolved upon the death, retirement, resignation expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member or manager, or upon the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the Company, unless the business of the Company is continued by the consent of all the remaining members, provided there are at least one remaining member.

ARTICLE 10 - INDEMNIFICATION

The Company shall indemnify managers and/or members of the Company wh was wholly successful, on the merits or otherwise, in the defense of any proceedir to which the managers and/or members was a party because the managers and/o members is or was a manager and/or member of the Company against reasonab attorney fees and expenses incurred by the managers and/or members in connectic with the proceeding. If any word, clause or sentence of the foregoing provisions regardir indemnification or advancement of the attorney fees or expenses shall be held inval as contrary to law or public policy, it shall be severable and the provisions remainir shall not be otherwise affected. All references in these Articles of Organization "member", "manager", "employee" and "agent" shall include the heirs, estate executors, administrators and personal representatives of such persons.
