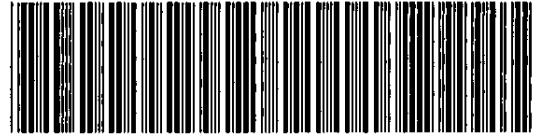

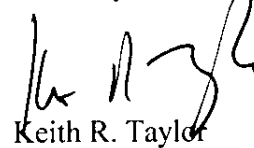

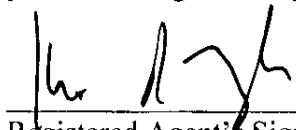

ARTICLE X- LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

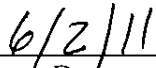
