These Articles of Correction correct the Articles of Organization, which were filed on July 1, 2001, and having document number L11000077075.

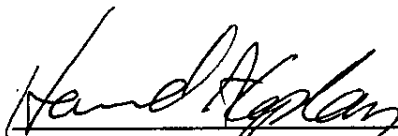
