ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF LAW-HURT, L.L.C

Pursuant to the provisions of Florida Statute 608.411 of the Florida Limited Liability Act, the undersigned Company adopts the following Articles of Amendment of its Articles of Organization:

FIRST: The name of the limited liability company is: LAW-HURT, L.L.C.

SECOND: The date of filing of the Articles of Organization was: September 13, 2011.

THIRD: The Articles of Organization of LAW-HURT, L.L.C. are hereby amended as follows:

ARTICLE V is hereby deleted.

The following Articles are hereby added to the Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE VII - DURATION\CONTINUATION

The duration of this limited liability company is perpetual from the date of commencement of the limited liability company's existence. The date and time of commencement of the limited liability company's existence is the time of filing of its original Articles of Organization by the Department of State of the State of Florida.

All membership interests shall be identical in all respects except the non-voting membership interests shall carry no right to vote on any matter except as the State of Florida requires that voting rights be granted non-voting membership interests pursuant to Chapter 608, Florida Statutes.

In addition to the indemnification conferred in this Article, the Indemnitee shall also be entitled to have paid directly by the Company the expenses reasonably incurred in defending any such proceeding against such Indemnitee in advance of its final disposition, to the fullest extent authorized by applicable law, as the same exists or may hereafter be amended. The rights and authority conferred by this Article shall not be exclusive of any other right which any person may have or hereafter acquire under any statute, provision of the Articles of Organization or Regulations of the Company, agreement, vote of Members or otherwise. Any repeal or amendment of this Article by the Members of the Company shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a member of officer existing at the time of such repeal or amendment.

ARTICLE XIII - ADOPTION OF OPERATING AGREEMENT

The Company may adopt an Operating Agreement for the Company, which Operating Agreement may contain any provision for the regulation and management of the affairs of the Company not inconsistent with these Articles of Organization or Chapter 608, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE XIV - INFORMAL ACTION OF MEMBERS

Any action of the Members may be taken without a meeting if consent in writing setting forth the action so taken shall be signed by all Members who would be entitled to vote upon such action at a meeting.

The foregoing Amendments were adopted by the members of the Company on this 15th day of September, 2011.
