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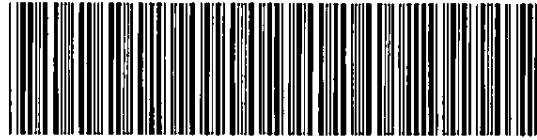
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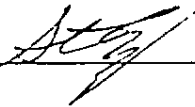

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**AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION  
OF  
MARGIN FREE, LLC**

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**SECTION 1 INTRODUCTION AND PRELIMINARY STATEMENTS**

The undersigned Manager desires to amend and restate the Articles of Organization of Margin Free, LLC, a Florida a limited liability company by delivering these Amended and Restated Articles of Organization in duplicate to the Department of State of the State of Florida, in accordance with Florida Revised Limited Liability Company Act (the *Act*). These Amended and Restated Articles of Organization were approved by the Members of Margin Free, LLC.

**SECTION 2 NAME**

The name of the limited liability company is Margin Free, LLC, a Florida limited liability company (**Company**).

**SECTION 3 DURATION**

The Company will perpetually exist from the filing date of these Articles of Organization with the Department of State of the State of Florida, unless dissolved according to law.

**SECTION 4 COMPANY'S PURPOSE**

The Company's purpose is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which limited liability companies may be formed under the Act, and all activities necessary or incidental to that purpose. The Company has all the powers necessary or convenient to carry out its purposes, including the powers granted by the Act.

**SECTION 5 COMPANY'S PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND LOCATION OF RECORDS**

The street address of the principal office in the United States where the Company maintains its records is 2017 GEORGE JENKINS BLVD, Lakeland, Florida 33815.

**SECTION 6 REGISTERED AGENT AND REGISTERED OFFICE**

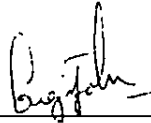
The Company's initial Registered Agent is Gigi John, and the Company's initial registered office is located at 2446 Hamlet Circle, Lakeland, Florida 33810.

**SECTION 7 REGISTERED AGENT CONSENT**

I, Gigi John, a natural person and resident of Florida, accept the appointment as Registered Agent of Margin Free, LLC, a Florida limited liability company. I understand that my responsibilities as Registered Agent are to receive service of process, notices, and demands; to forward mail; and to

notify the Department of State immediately if I resign or if the registered office address changes from the addresses stated above.

## **SECTION 8 ADDITIONAL MEMBERS**

The Company has the right to admit additional Members to the Company under the terms and conditions of the Company's Operating Agreement. Any Member who is later admitted as a Member of the Company will have all of the rights and obligations of an original Member under the Operating Agreement. Any transferee of a Member's Membership Interest in the Company must be treated as an Assignee until that transferee is admitted as an additional or substitute Member, if ever, under the Operating Agreement.

## **SECTION 9 BUSINESS CONTINUATION**

If a Member's Membership Interest in the Company is terminated by a terminating event, the remaining Members of the Company have the right to continue the Company's business under the terms of the Operating Agreement. A terminating event may include the Member's death, disability, retirement, resignation, withdrawal, expulsion, or bankruptcy. If the remaining Members fail to continue the Company's business according to the terms of the Operating Agreement, the Company must be dissolved and liquidated under the Act and the Operating Agreement.

## **SECTION 10 OPERATING AGREEMENT AND AUTHORITY**

To the extent not expressly required by and provided for in the Act, the manner in which the Company conducts its business and affairs, the duties and authority of its Members and Managers, and the rights and obligations of its Members and Managers must be set forth in the Operating Agreement adopted by the initial Members and Managers of the Company. This Operating Agreement may be amended from time to time according to its provisions.

## **SECTION 11 MANAGEMENT**

Management of the Company is vested in the Managers. The Managers have exclusive authority to act for the Company in all matters. The authorities and duties of the Managers are set forth in the Operating Agreement. The names and addresses of the initial Managers are:

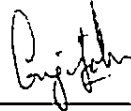
## SECTION 12 INDEMNIFICATION AND LIABILITY
