ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF NANCY C. HARRISON, ESQ., P.L. (PROFESSIONAL LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY)

The undersigned certify that we have associated ourselves together for the purpose of becoming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. We further declare that the following Articles shall serve as the Charter and authority for the conduct of business of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE I. NAME AND PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of the limited liability company shall be Nancy C. Harrison, Esq., P.L., and its principal office shall be located at 599 Atlantic Boulevard, Suite 5, in the City of Atlantic Beach, County of Duval, State of Florida, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices all any other place or places as the members may designate.

ARTICLE II. PURPOSES AND POWERS

ARTICLE V. MEMBERSHIP RESTRICTIONS

Members must be duly licensed or otherwise legally authorized to render legal service Membership will be restricted in accordance with Chapter 621, Florida Statutes.

Members shall have the right to admit new members by unanimous consent. Contributions required of new members shall be determined as of the time of admission to the limited liability company.

A member's interest in the limited liability company may not be sold or otherwise transferred except with the written consent of all members.

On the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member, or the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the limited liability company, the remaining members shall have the right to continue the business on unanimous consent of the remaining members. Limitation on issuance and transfer of ownership shall be in accordance with Section 621.09, Florida Statutes. Disqualification of members shall be in accordance with Section 621.10, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE VI. CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Capital contributions in the amount of \$10.00 and other valuable consideration—shall be paid to the limited liability company by the originating member. Initial contributions will be made as required for investment purposes, as determined by unanimous consent of the members. Thereafter members will make additional contributions in equal shares.

ARTICLE VII. PROFITS AND LOSSES

- (a) Profit Sharing. The members shall be entitled to the net profits arising from the operation of the limited liability company business that remain after the payment of the expenses of conducting the business of the limited liability company.
