ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

KEYSTONE REAL ESTATE INCOME LLC



The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Florida Statutes Chapter 608, hereby makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE 1 - NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be **KEYSTONE REAL ESTATE INCOME LLC** ("Company").

ARTICLE 2 - ADDRESS

The principal place of business of the Company in Florida shall be 3719 West Ohio Avenue, Tampa, Florida 33611, and the mailing address shall be P.O. Box 714, Tampa, Florida 33601.

ARTICLE 3 - EFFECTIVE DATE

These Articles of Organization shall be effective immediately upon approval of the Secretary of State, State of Florida.

ARTICLE 4 - DURATION

If any word, clause or sentence of the foregoing provisions regarding indemnification or advancement of the attorney fees or expenses shall be held invalid as contrary to law or public policy, it shall be severable and the provisions remaining shall not be otherwise affected. All references in these Articles of Organization to "member", "manager", "employee" and "agent" shall include the heirs, estates, executors, administrators and personal representatives of such persons.

ARTICLE 11 - UNITS

The Company shall be authorized to have two (2) classes of units of equity interest in the company: Class A unlimited voting manager class consisting of 2,000 units and Class B limited non-voting non-manager class consisting of 98,000 units.
