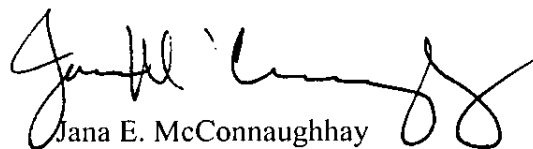

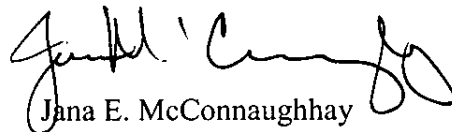

**ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION
OF
GLEN JULIA FAMILY LLC**

The undersigned, acting as the organizer of Glen Julia Family LLC under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 608, Fla. Stat., adopts the following Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I - Name:

The name of the limited liability company is Glen Julia Family LLC (the "Company").

ARTICLE II - Address:

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the Company is 2017 Beaver Creek Dr., Havana, FL 32333.

ARTICLE III - Duration:

The period of duration for the Company shall be perpetual, unless dissolved in accordance with the terms of the Operating Agreement of the Company.

ARTICLE IX - Indemnification:

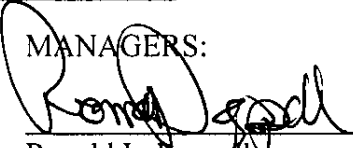
