ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

PHA-A-TIT INTERNATIONAL (USA) LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Florida Statutes Chapter 608, hereby makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE 1 - NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be PHA-A-TIT INTERNATIONAL (USA) LLC ("Company").

ARTICLE 2 - ADDRESS

The principal place of business of the Company shall be 322/65 Surawongwattanakarn Building, Surawongse Road, Sipraya, Bangrak, Bangkok 10500, Thailand, and the matting address shall be the same.

<u>ARTICLE 3 - EFFECTIVE DATE</u>

These Articles of Organization shall be effective immediately upon approval of the Secretary of State, State of Florida.

ARTICLE 4 - DURATION

Subject to the provisions of Article 9, the Company's existence shall terminate no later than 99 years from its date of commencement, unless the Company is earlier dissolved as provided in these Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE 5 - PURPOSES AND POWERS

The general purpose for which the Company is organized is to engage in the business of production of textiles, trade of gem stones and to transact any lawful business for which a limited liability company may be organized under the laws of the State of Florida. ARTICLE 8 - ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS

No additional Member(s) shall be admitted to the Company except upon such terms and conditions as shall be determined by all the Member(s).

ARTICLE 9 - TERMINATION OF EXISTENCE

The Company shall be dissolved upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a Member or Manager, or upon the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a Member in the Company, unless the business of the Company is continued by the consent of all the remaining Members, provided there is at least one remaining Member.

ARTICLE 10 - INDEMNIFICATION

The Company shall indemnify manager and/or member of the Company who was wholly successful, on the merits or otherwise, in the defense of any proceeding to which the manager and/or member was a party because the manager and/or member is or was a manager and/or member of the Company against reasonable attorney fees and expenses incurred by the manager and/or member in connection with the proceeding.
