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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF BLUEHILL FUND I, LLC

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 608, Florida Statutes, hereby makes, acknowledges, and files the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I -- NAME

SUMMARY OF MAJOR PROVISIONS OF OPERATING AGREEMENT BLUEHILL FUND 1, LLC

This Summary discusses some of the major provisions of the Operating Agreement of BLUEHILL FUND I, LLC ("Company"). All capitalized terms herein shall have the same meaning as described in the Operating Agreement. All section references refer to the Operating Agreement.

- 1. <u>Members</u>. As reflected on Exhibit "A", the Members are as follows: Andrew Reed and Joseph Won, each owning 50 units which represents 100% of the outstanding units in the Company.
- 2. <u>Management</u>. Under Article IV, the Managers are Andrew Reed and Joseph Won. The Managers have the authority to do most of the day to day operations of the business. Section 4.1(b) sets forth the Managers' general powers. So long as the Company approves an action, only one Manager's signature is required on documents. Section 4.1(c) sets forth extraordinary transactions which may not be undertaken by a Managers without approval of all of the Members. The Managers are elected by the Members holding a Majority of the Ownership Interests.
- 3. <u>Capital Contributions</u>. Additional Capital Contributions shall be made by each of the Members with the approval of all of the Members that the Company requires capital in addition to the additional initial capital contributions.
- 4. <u>Distributions</u>. "Net cash from operations" shall be distributed to the Members pro rata in accordance with the respective ownership interest, subject to the approval of the Members.
- 5. <u>Tax Matters Member</u>. Section 7.5 appoints Andrew Reed as tax matters member which essentially means that he is responsible for ensuring that tax filings are completed.
- 6. <u>Transfer of Member Interest.</u> No Member may assign, transfer, or otherwise dispose of such Member's interest to any person without the consent of the other Members, unless the Member desiring to sell first offers to sell the Membership Interest to the remaining Members **EXCEPT** a Member may transfer his interest to another Member, the transferring Member's spouse, descendents, trust or estate as set forth in Section 9.2 without the approval of the other Members. In the event of a transfer, the transferee must agree to become a party to the Operating Agreement.
- 7. <u>Allocations of Profits and Losses</u>. Profits and Losses shall be allocated among the Members in proportion to their respective ownership interests.
- 8. <u>Put/Call Option</u>. Article X gives a Member an opportunity to force another Member to either buy the offering Member's interest in the Company or sell his interest in the Company to the offering Member for a stated price.

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
