ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF COLLIER CLUB, LLC.

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, F.S. Chapter 608, hereby make, acknowledge, and file the following Articles of Organization.

ARTICLE I -- NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be COLLIER CLUB, LLC. ("Company").

ARTICLE II -- ADDRESS

The mailing address and street address of the principal office of the company shall be 621 17th Street, Vero Beach, Florida 32960.

ARTICLE III -- DURATION

The company shall commence its existence on the date these articles of organization are filed by the Florida Department of State. The company's existence shall be perpetual unless the company is earlier dissolved as provided in these articles of organization.

ARTICLE IV -- REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The name and street address of the registered agent of the company in the State of Florida is Barry G. Segal, P.A., 621 17th Street, Vero Beach, Florida 32960.

ARTICLE V -- ADDITIONAL CAPITAL CONTRIBUTIONS

Each member shall make additional capital contributions to the company only on the unanimous consent of all the members.

ARTICLE VI -- ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS

No additional members shall be admitted to the company except with the unanimous written consent of all the members of the company and on such terms and conditions as shall be determined by all the members. A member may transfer his or her interest in the company as set forth in the regulations of the company, but the transferee shall have no right to participate in the management of the business and affairs of the company or become a member unless all the other members of the company other than the member proposing to dispose of his or her interest approve of the proposed transfer by unanimous written consent.

ARTICLE VII -- TERMINATION OF EXISTENCE

The company shall be dissolved on the death, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a member of a manager, or on the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the company, unless the business of the company is continued by the consent of all the remaining members, provided there is at least one remaining member or the sole remaining member consents to the addition of a new member(s).

ARTICLE VIII -- MANAGEMENT

The company shall be managed by its manager, Robert Votaw, in accordance with regulations adopted by the members for the management of the business and affairs of the company. These regulations may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of the affairs of the company not inconsistent with law or these articles of organization.

The above notwithstanding, the Manger shall have the following powers and may act without evidence of the consent of the members or further authorization of the members or the production of an operating agreement for the Company:

- 1. Convey the real and personal property of the Company.
- 2. Execute any and all loan documents including, but not limited to, promissory notes, mortgages, security agreements, applications, resolutions and authorizations.
- 3. Without limiting the foregoing, complete those tasks required for the day to day operation of the Company.
- 4. Make and effectuate all personnel decisions concerning the employees, independent contractors and agents of the Company for the completion of the operation of the Company's business.

Any third party may rely upon an affidavit of the Manager that this delegation of powers is effective unless and until (1) an amendment of these Articles of Organization is filed with the Florida Department of State amending this article; and/or (2) a Notice of Limitation of Powers is recorded in the Public Records of Indian River County, Florida executed by either the Organizer (as identified below) or the majority of the then existing members of the Company.
