Articles of Organization

Of

A Florida Limited Liability Company

The undersigned (the "Member") acting as the organizer of Trinity Guide Service, LLC under the Florida Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 608, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Organization.

Article 1 Name

The name of the limited liability company is Trinity Guide Service, LLC (the "Company").

Article 2 Period of Duration

Unless earlier terminated under the Act or the Operating Agreement, the period of duration of the Company shall be perpetual.

Article 3 **Purposes, Powers and Capital Contributions**

- A. <u>Purposes.</u> The Company is organized to provide fishing guide services to the public. The Company is also organized for, and may engage in, any other lawful purposes.
- B. <u>Powers.</u> The Company shall have and may exercise all powers and rights which a limited liability company may exercise pursuant to Chapter 608, <u>Fla. Stat.</u>, as the same may be amended from time to time.
