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ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF LAW OFFICE OF GARY B. LEUCHTMAN, PLLC

I, the undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Organization, being a natural person competent to contract, do hereby make, subscribe, acknowledge, and file these Articles for the purpose of forming a Professional Limited Liability Company under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the limited liability company shall be Law Office of Gary B. Leuchtman, PLLC (the "Company").

ARTICLE TWO

The Company shall have perpetual existence commencing on the date of filing these Articles of Organization in the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE THREE

The Company is organized for the following purposes:

- (a) To provide professional legal services by and through its managers, officers, employees and agents who are duly licensed and otherwise legally authorized to render such professional services within the State of Florida.
- (b) To engage in every aspect and phase of the practice of law and the performance of services ancillary thereto that are customarily done by licensed attorneys at law under the laws of the State of Florida and in accordance with Chapter 621, Florida Statutes.
- (c) To own real and personal property, and to use, operate, maintain, remodel, improve and generally deal with and in the same, and any appurtenances convenient, desirable, or necessary in the conduct and operation of the lawful business of the Company.
- (d) To do all and everything necessary or proper for the accomplishment of the objects and purposes of the Company, as determined by the Company's members in their discretion and consistent with the laws of the State of Florida, or as necessary or incidental to the protection and benefit of the Company, and in general to carry out any lawful business, either as principal, agent, contractor, or otherwise, and either alone or in conjunction with any other persons, firm, associations, corporation, or other entities, both

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within and without the State of Florida, to the same extent as natural persons lawfully might or could do, insofar as acts may be permitted to be done by a Professional Limited Liability Company organized under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE FOUR

The principal place of business of the Company shall be 921 North Palafox Street, Pensacola, Florida 32501, or such other place or places as the members from time to time may determine. The name and address of the initial registered agent of the Company and the registered office shall be Gary B. Leuchtman, 921 North Palafox Street, Pensacola Florida 32501.

ARTICLE FIVE

The Company will be a Manager-Managed Company.

ARTICLE SEVEN

Individual members must be licensed to practice law in the State of Florida. The shareholders of any member that is a professional service corporation and members of any member that is a professional limited liability company must each be licensed to practice law in the State of Florida. Existing members shall have the right to admit new members by consent of members representing all of the ownership interests in the Company. Contributions required of new members shall be determined as of the time of admission to the Company in accordance with the Operating Agreement.

A member's interest in the Company may not be sold or otherwise transferred except to a person licensed to practice law in the State of Florida, with written consent of members representing all of the ownership interest in the Company and otherwise in accordance with the Operating Agreement of this Company.

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ARTICLE EIGHT

The remaining members of the Company may continue the business of the Company upon the termination of membership of a member in the Company (by reason of death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy or dissolution of a member of the occurrence of any other event terminating membership in the Company) upon unanimous agreement in accordance with the Operating Agreement of the Company.

ARTICLE NINE

The Company shall have all of the powers enumerated in the Florida Professional Service Corporations and Limited Liability Company Act, Chapter 621, Florida Stätutes, as such chapter presently exists or may hereafter be amended.
