

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

BAY TO BAY DENTAL ASSOCIATES, P.L.

The undersigned certifies that he has associated for the purpose of becoming a professional limited company under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of professional limited companies for profit under Chapters 605, as incorporated in Chapter 621, Florida Statutes. I further declare that the following Articles shall serve as the Charter and authority for the conduct of the professional limited company.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this Professional Limited Company is BAY TO BAY DENTAL ASSOCIATES, P.L.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

The duration of this Professional Limited Company shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

This Professional Limited Company is created and organized for the following purposes:

a. To engage in the practice of a denistry as a professional corporation and to own and

ARTICLE IV

ARTICLE VII

REGULATIONS

At the time of executing these Articles of Organization, the members of the Professional Limited Company shall adopt an operating agreement containing all provisions for the regulation and management of this company not inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida or these articles. The power to alter, amend or repeal these operating agreement shall be vested in the members of this company as decided by a majority vote.

ARTICLE VIII

TRANSFERABILITY OF MEMBERS' INTEREST

A member's interest in this Professional Limited Company may be transferred or

assigned, voluntarily or involuntarily, only with the unanimous written consent of all the remaining members of the Professional Limited Company. The transferee of interest of any member shall have no right to participate in the management of the business and the affairs of the Professional Limited Company or to become a member without unanimous written consent of all of the remaining members. The transferee shall be entitled to receive only the share of profits or other compensation by way of income or return of contributions to which that member otherwise would be entitled. Only duly licensed dentists shall be eligible to purchase membership interests in this Professional Limited Company.

ARTICLE IX

PROFITS AND LOSSES

The members of this Professional Limited Company shall be entitled to the net profits arising from the operation of the company business. Each member shall be entitled to his or her distributive share of the profits according to his or her pro rata contribution to capital and interest in the Professional Limited Company. Losses shall be passed through to each member in the same proportion according to his or her pro rata interest in the company.

ARTICLE X

WITHDRAWAL, RETIREMENT, DEATH, BANKRUPTCY OR EXPULSION

In the event of withdrawal, retirement, death, bankruptcy or expulsion of a member, this Professional Limited Company shall cease doing business and its existence shall terminate unless the remaining members, by written unanimous consent, agree to the continuation of the business.

ARTICLE XI

AMENDMENTS

These articles, except with respect to the vested rights of the members, may be amended from time to time by the unanimous vote in interest of the members, and the amendments shall then be filed, with the Florida Department of State after being duly executed by each of the members of the Professional Limited Company. All members of the Professional Limited Company agree to abide by the unanimous decision and agree to execute such amendments for the purpose of filing them with the Florida Department of State.
