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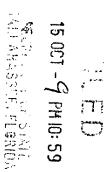

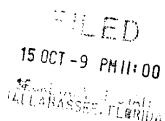

ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION FOR 910 HILLARY COURT, LLC A FLORIDA LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY



The undersigned, acting as the organizer of 910 Hillary Court, LLC (the "Company") under the Florida Revised Limited Liability Act, Chapter 605, Fla. Stat. adopts the following Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the limited liability company is 910 Hillary Court, LLC.

ARTICLE II INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The street address and mailing address of the initial principal office of this Company is 1600 Spring Lake Drive, Orlando, Florida 32804.

ARTICLE III REGISTERED OFFICE ADDRESS, INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT

The address of the initial registered office of this Company is 1600 Spring Lake Drive, and the name of the initial registered agent of this Company at that address is John Pinel, an individual.

ARTICLE IV DURATION

The Company's existence shall commence upon the acceptance of these Articles of Organization by the Secretary of State, and it shall exist perpetually thereafter unless dissolved according to law or the Company's Operating Agreement

ARTICLE V MANAGEMENT

The Company shall be managed by one or more managers as provided in the Company's Amended and Restated Operating Agreement and the initial managers of the Company shall be John Pinel and Don Saunders.

ARTICLE VI MEMBERSHIP INTERESTS

Each Membership Interest in the Company shall constitute a "security" within the meaning of, and governed by, (i) Article 8 of the Uniform Commercial Code (including Section 8-102(a)(15) thereof) as

in effect from time to time in the State of Florida, and (ii) Article 8 of the Uniform Commercial Code of any other applicable jurisdiction that now or hereafter substantially includes the 1994 revisions to Article 8 thereof as adopted by the American Law Institute and the National Conference of Commissioners on Uniform State Laws and approved by the American Bar Association on February 14, 1995. The Company shall maintain books for the purpose of registering the transfer of Membership Interests in the Company.

Notwithstanding any provision of the Company's Amended and Restated Operating Agreement to the contrary, to the extent that any provision of this Agreement is inconsistent with any non-waivable provision of Article 8 of the Uniform Commercial Code as in effect in the State of Florida (the "UCC"), such provision of Article 8 of the UCC shall control.

The Company shall issue only one (1) original Membership Interest certificate to the Member, which may be replaced in accordance with Section 8-405 of the UCC.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned authorized representative of the Company has duly executed these Articles of Organization as of the $\int_{-\infty}^{\pi u} day$ of October, 2015.
