ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF BIBUBOO, L.L.C.

The undersigned hereby certify that we have associated ourselves for the purpose of becoming a limited liability company under laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies for profit. We further declare that the following Articles shall be the Charter and authority for the conduct of such limited liability company.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be BIBUBOO, L.L.C., and its principal place of business shall be 420 W. Main Street, Apopka, FL 32712, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at such place or places as my be designated by the members.

ARTICLE II PURPOSES AND POWERS

The general nature of the business or businesses to be transacted and which the limited liability company is authorized to transact, in addition to those authorized by the laws of the State of Florida, and the powers of the limited liability company, shall be as follows:

- 1. To engage in any activity of business authorized under Florida Statutes.

- 4. To enter into and make all necessary contracts for its business with any person, entity, partnership, association, corporation, domestic or foreign, or of any domestic or foreign state, government, or governmental authority, or of any political or administrative subdivision, or department thereof, and to perform and carry out, assign, cancel, or rescind any of such contracts.
- 5. - 6. To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in association with others incidental or pertaining to, or going out of, or connected with its business or powers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.
- 7. The several clauses contained in this statement of the general nature of the businesses to be transacted shall be constructed as both purposes and powers of this limited liability company, and statements contained in each
