ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION FOR RICK KOZELL PLLC

(A Florida Professional Limited Liability Company)

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a professional limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida, pursuant to the Florida Revised Limited Liability Company Act, as amended from time to time (the "LLC Act") and the Professional Service Corporation and Limited Liability Company Act of the State of Florida (the "PLLC Act"), hereby adopts the following Articles of Organization:

ARTICLE 1 NAME

The name of the Professional Limited Liability Company is Rick Kozell PLLC (the "Company").

ARTICLE 2 DURATION

Notwithstanding the date of the filing of these Articles with the Secretary of State of the State of Florida, the effective date these Articles shall be January 1, 2017 (the "Formation Date"). This Company shall exist on the Formation Date. The duration of the Company shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE 5 INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT AND REGISTERED OFFICE:

ARTICLE 6 MANAGEMENT

The Company shall be manager-managed in accordance with the Company's Operating Agreement.

ARTICLE 7 MEMBERSHIP CERTIFICATES

Each Member's interest in the Company may be evidenced by a certificate of membership, as further set forth in the Company's Operating Agreement. No Member of the Company may transfer, sell or assign its membership interest in the Company to any other person except as provided for in the Company's Operating Agreement and permitted by the PLLC Act.

ARTICLE 8 INDEMNIFICATION

The Company shall indemnify to the fullest extent permitted under and in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida any person who was or is a party or is threatened to be made a party to any threatened, pending or completed action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative by reason of the fact that he, she or it is or was a manager, a member, or officer of the Company, or is or was serving at the request of the Company as a manager, member, director, officer, trustee, employee or agent of or in any other capacity with another company, partnership, joint venture, trust or other enterprise, against expenses (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees), judgments, fines and amounts paid in settlement actually and reasonably incurred by him in connection with such action, suit or proceeding.

Expenses (including, without limitation, attorney's fees) incurred by any member, manager, or officer in defending any civil, criminal, administrative or investigative proceeding shall be paid by the Company in advance of the final disposition of such proceeding upon receipt of an undertaking (secured or unsecured as may be determined by the Company) by or on behalf of such member, manager or officer to repay such amount if it shall ultimately be determined that such manager, manager or officer is not entitled to be indemnified by the Company as authorized in this Article 8. Such expenses (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees) incurred by other employees and agents shall also be so paid upon such terms and conditions, if any, as the Company deems appropriate.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, indemnification or advancement of expenses shall not be made to or on behalf of any member, manager, officer, employee, or agent if a judgment or other

final adjudication establishes that the actions, or omissions to act, of such member, manager, officer, employee, or agent were material to the cause of action so adjudicated and constitute any of the following:

- 8.1.1 A violation of criminal law, unless the member, manager, officer, employee, or agent had no reasonable cause to believe such conduct was unlawful.
- 8.1.2 A transaction from which the member, manager, officer, employee, or agent derived an improper personal benefit.
 - 8.1.3 A distribution in violation of Section 605.0406 of the LLC Act.
- 8.1.4 Willful misconduct or a conscious disregard for the best interests of the Company in a proceeding by or in the right of the Company to procure a judgment in its favor or in a proceeding by or in the right of a member.
- 8.1.5 Recklessness, or an act or omission committed in bad faith or with malicious purpose or in a manner exhibiting wanton and willful disregard of human rights, safety or property in a proceeding by or in the right of someone other than the Company or a member.

The indemnification provided by this <u>Article 8</u> shall continue as to an indemnified person who has ceased to be a member, manager, officer, employee, or agent and shall inure to the benefit of the estate, heirs, personal representatives, beneficiaries, executors and administrators of such person. All rights to indemnification and advances under this <u>Article 8</u> shall be deemed to be a contract between the Company and each indemnified person at any time while this <u>Article 8</u> is in effect. Any repeal or modification of this <u>Article 8</u> or any repeal or modification of relevant provisions of the LLC Act or any other applicable laws shall not in any way diminish the rights to indemnification of such indemnified person or the obligations of the Company arising hereunder for claims relating to matters occurring prior to the repeal or modification.

ARTICLE 9 AMENDMENT

The Company reserves the right to amend or repeal any provision contained in these Articles of Organization, and any right conferred upon the Member is subject to this reservation.
