



The undersigned, Ministry Village at Olive, Inc., a Florida not-for-profit corporation, hereby certifies that it has formed a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida. Florida Statutes Chapter 605, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies. It further declares that the following Articles shall be the authority for the conduct of the charitable purposes of such limited liability company.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the limited liability company shall be MINISTRY VILLAGE EARLY LEARNING CENTER, L.L.C., and its principal place of business shall be in Pensacola, County of Escambia, State of Florida, but it shall have the power and authority to establish branch offices at such place or places as may be designated by the members.

ARTICLE II PURPOSES AND POWERS

The Company is organized exclusively for educational purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The purposes for which the Company is formed and the objectives to be carried on and promoted by it are as follows:

To operate one or more schools dedicated to provide an opportunity for preschool age children to work, play, learn and worship in a loving, safe, and caring Christian environment through experiences intended to foster a lifetime love for learning and create leaders in Christ.

To instill students with the love of Christ and a capacity for life-long learning that will lead them to becoming extraordinary Christian adults. To provide a caring organization where God ignites faith, changes lives and empowers people to reach children and families with the love of Christ, using a holistic approach that involves the student's family, parent and guardian, as well as the student. The Early Learning Center is committed to the design of learning environments that foster the acquisition of knowledge, skills, and wisdom in a climate of caring, cooperation and mutual respect. The school is dedicated to create learning environments that teach civility and character.

To carry out this purpose, the Company may exercise the powers permitted under Chapter 605 of the Florida Statutes; provided, however, that this Company, in exercising any one or more of such powers shall do so in furtherance of the exempt purpose for which it and its only member, Ministry Village at Olive, Inc. have been organized as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

The Company is irrevocably dedicated to and operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes; and no part of the income or assets of the Company shall be distributed to, nor inure to the benefit of any member, director, officer, or other private persons, except that the Company


shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services actually rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its exempt purposes.

In the event of dissolution, winding up, or other liquidation of the assets of this Company, the residual assets of the Company will be turned over only to Ministry Village at Olive, Inc, a Florida not-for-profit corporation or one or more other organizations created and operated for non-profit purposes similar to those of Ministry Village at Olive, Inc, and which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding sections of any or future law, or to the Federal. State or local government for exclusive public purpose.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this Company will not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law or (b) an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or any other corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law.

The Company shall have all of the powers granted to limited liability companies under the laws of the state of Florida, including, but not limited to the following powers:

- 1. In general, to carry on any and all incidental business; to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida, and to do any and all things herein set forth to the same extent as a natural person might or could do.
- 2. To purchase or otherwise acquire, undertake, carry on, improve, or develop, all or any of the business, good will, rights, assets, and liabilities of any person, firm, association, or corporation carrying on any kind of business of a similar nature to that which this limited liability company is authorized to carry on, pursuant to the provisions of the Articles; and to hold, utilize, and in any manner dispose of the rights and property so acquired.
- 3. To enter into and make all necessary contracts for its business with any person, entity, partnership, association, corporation, domestic or foreign, or of any domestic or foreign state, government, or governmental authority, or of any political or administrative subdivision, or department thereof, and to perform and carry out, assign, cancel, or rescind any of such contracts.
- 4. To exercise all or any of the limited liability company powers, and to carry out all or any of the purposes, enumerated herein otherwise granted or permitted by law, while acting as agent, nominee, or attorney-in-fact for any persons or corporations, and perform any service under contract or otherwise for any corporation, joint stock company, association, partnership, firm, syndicate, individual, or other entity, and in such capacity or under such arrangement develop, improve, stabilize, strengthen, or extend the property and commercial interest thereof, and to aid, assist, or participate in any lawful enterprise in connection therewith or incidental to such agency,



representation, or service, and to render any other service or assistance insofar as it lawfully may under the laws of the State of Florida, providing for the formation, rights, privileges, and immunities of limited liability companies.

5. To do everything necessary, proper, advisable, or convenient for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, or the attainment of any of the objects, or the furtherance of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in association with others incidental or pertaining to, or going out of, or connected with its business or powers, provided the same shall not be inconsistent with the laws of the State of Florida.

Nothing herein contained shall be deemed or construed as authorizing or permitting, or purporting to authorize or permit the limited liability company to carry on any business, exercise any power, or do any act which a limited liability company may not, under the laws of the State of Florida, lawfully carry on, exercise, or do.

ARTICLE III LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANY POWERS

All limited liability company powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of this limited liability company shall be managed under the direction of, the Ministry Village at Olive, Inc., member of this limited liability company. This article may be amended from time to time in the regulations of the limited liability company by the member of the limited liability company.

ARTICLE IV DURATION

This limited liability company shall be perpetual or until dissolved in a manner provided by law, or as provided in the regulations adopted by the members.

ARTICLE V PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The principal office of this limited liability company shall be located at 1830 E. Olive Road, Pensacola, Fl. 32514. The mailing address is 1830 E. Olive Road, Pensacola, FL 32514.

ARTICLE VI MANAGEMENT

This limited liability company shall be managed by one or more managers, as determined by the member, Ministry Village at Olive, Inc.. The name and address of the person who shall serve as manager until the first annual meeting of members or until successors are elected and qualify is STAN C. LOLLAR, III, 1830 E. Olive Road, Pensacola, FL 32514.

ARTICLE VII INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

The address of the initial registered office of the limited liability company is 1830 E. Olive Road, Pensacola, FL 32514, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is STAN C. LOLLAR, III.


