STATEMENT OF FACTS


In the summer of 2023, my TD Bank accounts and the TD App on my phone were hacked including ATC Fishermen's account. They stole my identity, were able to get a debit card in my name with the ability to steal cash from my account. I was unaware of the fraud until I received a letter from US Bank in the mail stating that I had not submitted enough information to get approved for a loan, I had not applied for a loan. The hackers applied for loans and tried opening new bank accounts in my name. I had to close all of my bank accounts in TD and open new ones. I reported the thefts to our local police, IdentityTheft.gov, Transunion, Equifax and Experian. Ultimately TD found that it was one of their employees that had stolen my information.

I was not aware that someone had fraudulently gone onto Sunbiz and dissolved ATC Fishermen until I tried to renew our 2024 Corporate Filing. I tried to reinstate the Company and got a message it was not eligible for reinstatement. When I looked at the Articles of Dissolution the reason given was "Company No Longer Needed" and my name was listed as the person affirming the Dissolution. This was not true, I did not dissolve the Company. When I saw that it had occurred in July of 2023, I thought it must have been the people that stole my identity. I did not authorize the dissolution, we would like for ATC Fishermen LLC to be reinstated as the Company is needed.
