ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION

OF

OLE' TALLAHASSEE HOLDING COMPANY, LLC

The undersigned, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 605, Florida Statutes (the "Florida Revised Limited Liability Company Act"), for the purpose of forming a limited liability company under the laws of the State of Florida do set forth the following:

- 1. NAME. The name of the limited liability company is OLE TALLAHASSEE HOLDING COMPANY, LLC (hereinafter referred to as the "Company").
- 2. PERIOD OF DURATION. The period of duration of the Company shall be from the date of filing of its Articles of Organization until the first to occur of the following:
 - (i) Dissolution of the Company pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Revised Limited

 Liability Company Act; or
 - outstanding membership interests in the Company; or
 - (iii) As provided for in a written Operating Agreement (the "Operating Agreement") executed by all of the members of the Company (each a "Member" and, collectively, the "Members").
- 3. PURPOSE. The purpose for which the Company is organized is to own, develop, operate, manage, maintain, mortgage, lease and sell real estate, and to engage in any and all related businesses and activities permitted by the laws of the State of Florida. The Company shall have all of the powers vested in a limited liability company organized and existing by virtue of such laws.
- 4. ADDRESS OF PLACE OF BUSINESS. The street address and mailing address for the Company is 3520 Thomasville Road, Suite 200, Tallahassee, Florida 32309. Such addresses may be changed from time to time as provided in the Operating Agreement.

6. MEMBERS. The Company shall have at least one (1) Member may admit additional Members upon the prior unanimous written agreement of the then existing Members, or as otherwise provided in the Operating Agreement. The Company may establish more than one (1) class of Members. In such a case, the rights, duties and privileges of each such class shall be as set forth in the Operating Agreement.

Membership, ownership or other interest in the Company may be represented by (or measured in) units (collectively, "Units" and each, separately, a "Unit"), as more specifically provided for in the Operating Agreement. - 7. CONTINUITY OF BUSINESS. Upon the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy, or dissolution of a Member or the occurrence of any other event which terminates the continued membership of a Member in the Company, the business of the Company shall be continued, and the Company shall not be dissolved without the prior written consent of all the remaining Members (if any) of the Company, except as expressly provided otherwise in the Operating Agreement.
- 8. MANAGEMENT. The management of the Company shall be through one or more Managers. Any Manager may be (but is not required to be) a Member of the Company.
