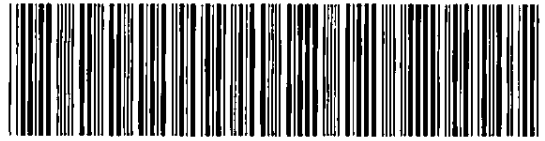

## Articles of Dissolution for a Limited Liability Company

Item: 4

Sometime around the end of August 2023, immediately after Hurricane Idalia, I drove from West Virginia, where I live, to Florida to develop a business plan that I have had for a number of years. It was my intention to purchase a used camper, hire a small work crew, obtain government and/or insurance company contracts, and chase around hurricane disaster relief work.

In order to expedite the licensing process, I employed the services of a consulting agency called Inc Authority. I set up a virtual mailing account with IPostal.com at a shared office space in Clearwater, Florida and began to recruit employees. I also agreed to pay additional fees to Inc Authority for ongoing business consulting advice.


It was after opening up a business bank account, and then attempting to purchase a camper from my personal checking account through the same bank, that I began to notice signs of manipulation in my accounts that indicated identity theft. Immediately after, I began to notice problems with other accounts, all of which were directly connected to information that I provided to Inc Authority.

For these reasons, I decided to shut down my business, and close all accounts connected to it. While on the phone with the IRS when attempting to deactivate my EIN #, I ran into more problems. The IRS representative told me that her systems would not allow her to close the account. After eventually getting my EIN account closed, I was

given the mailing address for the IRS Entity Department in Kansas City with the suggestion that I write them a letter reporting high level identity theft against Inc Authority.

I followed through on this suggestion, and have further filed statements and complaints with the Federal Trade Commission, and the Better Business Bureau. These statements have been published by the BBB as an official fraud report and accepted as a formal complaint. To ensure that my personal accounts are secure and that this privacy breach has been fully addressed, I request the dissolution of the business entity Regional & Recovery Contracting Services, LLC.
