ARTICLE I NAME

ARTICLE VII MEMBERSHIP

Except as expressly provided in a written operating agreement executed by all members, the Company shall have at least one member at all times and may only admit additional members upon the prior, unanimous agreement of all then-existing members.

Notwithstanding any oral or written agreement to the contrary, a person or entity who is a prospective member of the Company does not attain status as a member unless the Company has issued a valid equity unit certificate in the name of the member that is signed by the Company's manager or other duly authorized representative. The certificate need not be sealed. The certificate may be dated on a date that is different from the date of its execution, and, if so dated, a prospective according to the date written on the certificate.

ARTICLE VIII CONTINUITY

Except as expressly provided in a written operating agreement, on the death, retirement, resignation, expulsion, bankruptcy or dissolution of a member, or on the occurrence of any other event that terminates the continued membership of a member in the Company, or upon any other event that, under the Act, would result in dissolution of the Company, the business of the Company may be continued and the Company will not be dissolved without the written consent of the Company's remaining members.
